OBSTETRICS

Physicians applying for an appointment in Obstetrics in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology must be certified in the specialty.

A-OBS	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians trained and/or certified in Obstetrics.	Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
B-OBS	Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment and/or training as approved by the Chief of the Department including: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fetal invasive procedures 2. Percutaneous umbilical blood sampling 3. Genetic amniocentesis 4. Chorionic villus sampling 5. Decompression amniocentesis 6. A-GYN	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians trained and/or certified in Gynaecology.	Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or an Academic Certificate from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
B-GYN	<p>Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment and/or training as approved by the Chief of the Department, including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Gynaecologic Oncology 2. Pelvic surgery for complicated gynaecology cases including the necessary bowel and bladder surgery, repeat retropubic urethropexy and pelvic floor repair 3. Second trimester pregnancy termination by dilatation and evacuation 4. Colposcopy and lower genital tract laser 5. Laser Laparoscopy 6. Trans vaginal ultra sonography including sono hystero-graphy and Transvaginal needle aspiration of pelvic cysts 7.
