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RE: **Infection Control Summary Tab**

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Below is an outline of the details of the Infection Control Summary Tab that will be visible for staff. The Summary Tab will be located beside the Allergy tab and will be relevant at this point for those inpatients who are admitted from the Emergency department.

When viewing the Infection Control Summary Tab you will find five (5) sections:

1. ARO and CDAD status - This section shows the date that an MRSA, VRE or Cdiff flag has been applied. This data has only been collected since September 2009.
2. Precautions Orders – Not applicable at this time – Under development
3. Initial FRI/ILI Screening Results – This section shows the data from the Emergency Registration. These details should reflect the content on the current Screening form. Paper screening will continue from the Emergency department at this point.
4. ED/UCC Precautions Initiated – This section reflects the Additional Precautions that have been in place in the Emergency department. Implementation and Discontinuation status values are available.
5. Additional Precautions Details – This section describes the requirements for each type of Additional precaution. This condensed list is a reference for the patient placement details as well as the Personal Protective Equipment required for staff during care.
